State Level Information:

Developments larger than one acre and for sites that are under one acre, but part of a larger development must file a Notice of Intent with the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) to work under their Rule 5 general permit.

Drainage permits are required for any project that has land alterations that will impact storm water flows, absorption, drainage patterns, and runoff rates. These projects will require drainage approval from the City of Indianapolis Department of Business and Neighborhood Services.
